

SAFETY IN SCIENCE

In addition to general school rules, the following will also apply in Science laboratories:

1. Do not enter the lab until the teacher tells you.
2. Always walk, never run and watch where you are going.
3. Listen carefully to the teacher's instructions and follow them.
4. Never touch anything without the teacher's permission.
5. During practical work use your normal speaking voice.
6. Follow all safety precautions that your teacher tells you about.
7. Wear safety goggles wherever necessary.
8. Report all breakages and spillages to your teacher.
9. Do not carry out your own experiments without first checking with your teacher.
10. Do not put anything in your mouth unless your teacher tells you.
11. Do not leave bags etc., in the gangways.
12. Always form an orderly queue when waiting for apparatus.
13. Behave in an orderly manner and do not 'play about' with apparatus.
14. Wash your hands after working in a lab.
15. You are advised to wear protective clothing eg. an old shirt to protect your uniform.
